Rise As One—A Live Solidarity Concert by Joe Jencks. This recording is dedicated to all the laborers, organizers, advocates, and cultural workers, known and unknown, who have devoted their lives to solidarity.

Golden Lands, Working Hands by AFT/AFL-CIO. A history of the labor movement in California. Includes wonderful old footage of San Francisco, Los Angeles and other California cities.

Meeting Face To Face—The Iraq-US Labor Solidarity Tour by The Center for Study of Working Class Life. Follows six Iraqi labor leaders though 25 US cities on a tour sponsored by US Labor Against the War. The Iraqis explain why the primary condition for a peaceful resolution in Iraq is ending the US occupation and why an independent labor movement is crucial in creating a democratic society.

Rights on the Line: Vigilantes at the Border by AFSC, Witness, and ACLU. Tells the story of border crossers and communities whose rights are being violated and provides a close-up look at vigilantes. Includes a DVD in English and a DVD in Spanish.

I Know I'm Not Alone—A Musician's Search for the Human Cost of War by Michael Franti. A musical journey through war and occupation in Iraq, Israel and Palestine about the everyday people and the often overlooked human cost of war.

Inside Iraq—The Untold Stories by Mike Shiley. Stories about the lives of the Iraq people and US soldiers. Includes a children's landmine hospital, remote villages, soldiers who are finding creative solutions, and walking the streets of Baghdad.
